I am requesting funding for the Computer Aided Dispatch Replacement project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Baltimore Police Department, located at 601 E Fayette Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21202. The \$5,000,000 in funding would be used for the replacement of the City's aging Computer-Aided Dispatch System that is nearly twenty years old, eliminating future disruptions in daily operations and interoperability. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because Baltimore is in need of a replacement for their aging Computer-Aided Dispatch System, which is used by fire, police, and other city agencies to prioritize and record calls as an emergency or non-emergency incident.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8).
