
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the CyberSmart: A Cyber Safety and STEM Learning Program project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the National Association of Police Athletic Activities Leagues Inc., located at 601 Pennsylvania Ave., NW South Building, Suite 900 Washington, DC 20004. The funding would be used for the implementation and assessment throughout Maryland PAL chapters of a pilot cyber safety and STEM learning program, CyberSmart, aimed at protecting youth from cyber bullying, luring youth into criminal activity, human trafficking, and sexual exploitation, theft, and fraud, while also teaching STEM skills and career awareness. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help Maryland youth to recognize and avoid online risks such as scams, phishing, and malware. Additionally, CyberSmart provides a platform for law enforcement and youth to engage in meaningful connections and discussions related to the growing challenge of youth-targeted cybercrime on social media, gaming, and AI platforms.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
